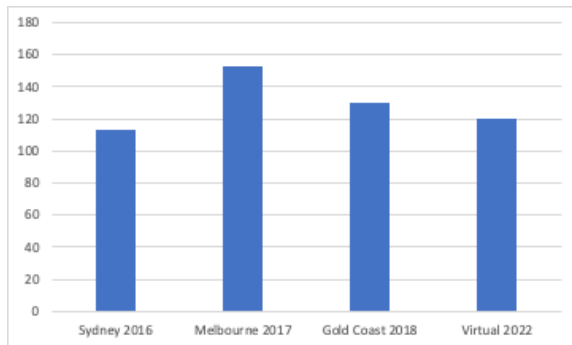
Sessions will be held from 9.15AM to 5PM time each day.

## Audience

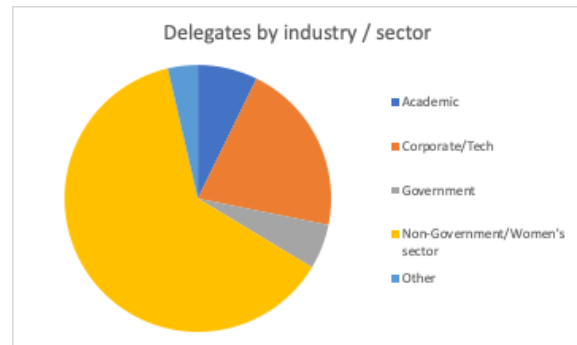
